Learn About Social Security Disability Benefits

Alison Packard (Packard Law Firm - San Antonio) will provide an overview of disability benefits available through the Social Security Administration, including Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and Childhood Disability Benefits (CDB). She will discuss the medical and technical eligibility requirements for a disability determination, appeal options, general reporting requirements, SSI resource and income calculations (including earned income, unearned income such as child support, deemed income and in-kind support and maintenance) and the use of special needs trusts and ABLE accounts to maximize benefits.
