

**Texas A&M University-San Antonio  
Student Vaccine Incentive Program  
Terms and Conditions**

**NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR  
RESTRICTED BY LAW.**

By participating in the Texas A&M University-San Antonio Student Vaccine Incentive Program (“**Incentive Program**”), you hereby acknowledge and agree to the following terms and conditions (these “**Terms**”):

1. **Voluntary Participation:** Participation in the Incentive Program is completely voluntary. You are not required to receive a COVID-19 Vaccination (as defined below) in order to attend Texas A&M University-San Antonio (“**A&M-San Antonio**”).
2. **Sponsor:** A&M-San Antonio is the sponsor of the Incentive Program.
3. **Entry Period:** The Incentive Program will begin on September 30, 2021 at 12:00 a.m. Central Time (“**CT**”) and end on October 28, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. CT (the “**Entry Period**”).
4. **Eligibility:** An individual is eligible to enter the Incentive Program if he/she meets all of the following requirements (each, an “**Eligible Individual**”):
  - A. He/she is a student enrolled at A&M-San Antonio as of September 3, 2021 for at least six (6) credit hours (each, a “**Qualified Student**”);
  - B. He/she is eighteen years of age or older;
  - C. He/she is not (1) involved in the administration of the Incentive Program (each, a “**Disqualified Individual**”), (2) a spouse, child, step-child, parent, step-parent, sibling, or step-sibling of a Disqualified Individual, or (3) an individual living in the same household as a Disqualified Individual at the time of the Drawing (as defined below); and
  - D. He/she has received a full dosage, which currently is either one or two shots depending on the type of vaccine and manufacturer, of either: (a) a COVID-19 vaccine recognized by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“**CDC**”) ([see list here](#)); or (b) a COVID-19 vaccine recognized by the World Health Organization (“**WHO**”) as having met the necessary criteria for safety and efficacy ([see list here](#)) (each, a “**COVID-19 Vaccination**”).
5. **How to Enter:** Eligible Individuals may enter the Incentive Program (“**Participants**”) by submitting an entry form to the A&M-San Antonio Voluntary COVID-19 Vaccination Reporting Portal (the “**Vaccine Reporting Portal**”) during the Entry Period (each, an “**Entry**”).
6. **Number of Entries:** Each Participant will only receive one (1) Entry into the Incentive Program.
7. **Prizes:**

- A. The prizes for the Incentive Program consist of ten (10) Visa or Mastercard gift cards, each in the amount of \$500 (each, a “**Prize**”, and collectively, the “**Prizes**”).
  - B. Each Participant can only win one (1) Prize.
8. **Winners:**
- A. Winners will be selected from among the Participants (each, a “**Winner**” and collectively, the “**Winners**”) in a random drawing conducted by A&M-San Antonio on or about November 1, 2021 (the “**Drawing**”).
  - B. A&M-San Antonio will notify each Winner by contacting them at the email address or phone number provided by the Winner on their Entry form.
  - C. Winners must acknowledge acceptance of the Prize in writing within five (5) days, sign an acknowledgment and consent form, and provide A&M-San Antonio with the Winner’s CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card or WHO International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis (WHO Yellow Card) (collectively, the “**Official Documentation**”). Failure to do so will result in the Winner’s forfeiture of the Prize, and A&M-San Antonio will randomly draw another Winner to receive the Prize from among the remaining Participants (with each alternate Winner having five (5) days to respond to A&M-San Antonio).
  - D. A Winner may refuse to accept the Prize, in which case that Prize will be awarded to another Winner randomly drawn from among the remaining Participants (with each alternate Winner having five (5) days to respond to A&M-San Antonio).
9. **Alternate Method of Entry:** In order to become a Participant without submitting Official Documentation to A&M-San Antonio, an Alternately Eligible Individual (as defined below) may mail a postcard with their name, email address, phone number, and the words “Texas A&M University-San Antonio Student Vaccine Incentive Program” to the following address: One University Way, Frank L. Madla Building Suite 312, San Antonio, TX, 78224. Postcards must be received by A&M-San Antonio by October 28, 2021 to be considered an Entry into the Incentive Program. An “**Alternately Eligible Individual**” means an individual who is (i) a Qualified Student, (ii) at least eighteen years of age, and (iii) not (1) a Disqualified Individual, (2) a spouse, child, step-child, parent, step-parent, sibling, or step-sibling of a Disqualified Individual, or (3) an individual living in the same household as a Disqualified Individual at the time of the Drawing.
10. **Taxes:** The Prizes may be taxable, and Winners are responsible for payment of any taxes or fees associated with the Prizes.
11. **Privacy:** A&M-San Antonio will maintain the confidentiality of your Official Documentation in accordance with applicable privacy laws. Participants authorize A&M-San Antonio to verify their identity and the accuracy of their Official Documentation with the ImmTrac2 Immunization Registry of the Texas Department of State Health Services or another official database if vaccinated outside of Texas.
12. **Publicity:** Participants understand and agree that, if they win a Prize, A&M-San Antonio may publicly disclose their name, image, and other directory information (such as

classification and program of study) for the purposes of announcing the Winners of the Prizes.

13. **Waiver of Liability:** A&M-San Antonio shall not be liable to any Participant in the Incentive Program for any damages, claims, expenses or other costs or fees (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees) that any Participant suffers or incurs as a result of his/her participation in the Incentive Program or receipt of a Prize.
14. **General:** A&M-San Antonio has the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, suspend, cancel or terminate the Incentive Program at any time, for any reason, without any liability to Participants or any other persons. A&M-San Antonio also has the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who violates any of these Terms; commits fraud or other misconduct in connection with the Incentive Program; or interferes with, disrupts, tampers with, circumvents, or otherwise undermines the Entry process, the Vaccine Reporting Portal or the operation of the Incentive Program. Participants understand and agree that any decisions with respect to the Incentive Program made by A&M-San Antonio will be binding and final in all respects.
15. **Governing Law and Venue:** The Incentive Program (including the interpretation of these Terms) shall be governed by and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. The venue for any dispute shall be Bexar County, Texas.

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
