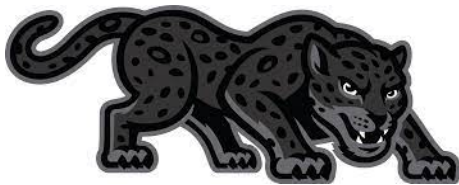
Dr. Rebekah Piper
