If I want to participate in the crossing the stage graduation celebration, do I need to register?

Yes, graduates are required to register.

Graduates are encouraged to attend in regalia (cap & gown).

How many family members can join me?

****Each graduate will have a guest maximum of 10.**

****Anyone over the age of five should be included in your total count.**

****The commencement ceremony will take place in the Auditorium with stage party and students in the auditorium while guests will be allowed at different locations through campus and watch the ceremony while it streams live.**

Will there be tickets for the event?

Yes. Guests will be required to have a wristband in lieu of a ticket.

Wristbands should be picked up by graduate (only), at the Welcome Center, Madla Room 111, beginning Monday, November 29th through Friday, December 10th.

Graduate please be ready to present a photo ID at the time of wristband pick up.

Where is the Event parking for Guests or Graduates?

Event parking is located in Lot 2 and 3 (campus map [here](#))

What time should I arrive?

Arrival time one hour before ceremony.
