

## Guidance for when General Liability Insurance is Required of a Guest

- 1. Are the activities expected to be completed by the Guest, similar to a typical student classroom lecture (excluding laboratory activities)? Yes or No
  - a. If **yes**, does the Guest represent a potentially controversial platform (i.e. will their presence and/or agenda create a long discussion among people with opposing opinions that has the potential for a negative outcome such as inciting riots or protests?) Yes or No
    - i. If **yes**, insurance will be required.
    - ii. If **no**, insurance will not be required.
  - b. If **no**, what are the activities expected to be performed by the Guest? Please complete the A&M-San Antonio Risk Assessment Matrix and submit to the A&M-San Antonio Risk Manager, Rita Arredondo <u>rsarredo@tamusa.edu</u>. The completed Risk Assessment Matrix will be used to help determine if insurance will be required of the Guest.
- 2. If the activities expected to be completed by the Guest are similar to a laboratory setting, please complete the A&M-San Antonio Risk Assessment Matrix and submit to the A&M-San Antonio Risk Manager, Rita Arredondo <a href="mailto:rsarredo@tamusa.edu">rsarredo@tamusa.edu</a>. The completed Risk Assessment Matrix will be used to help determine if insurance will be required of the Guest.
