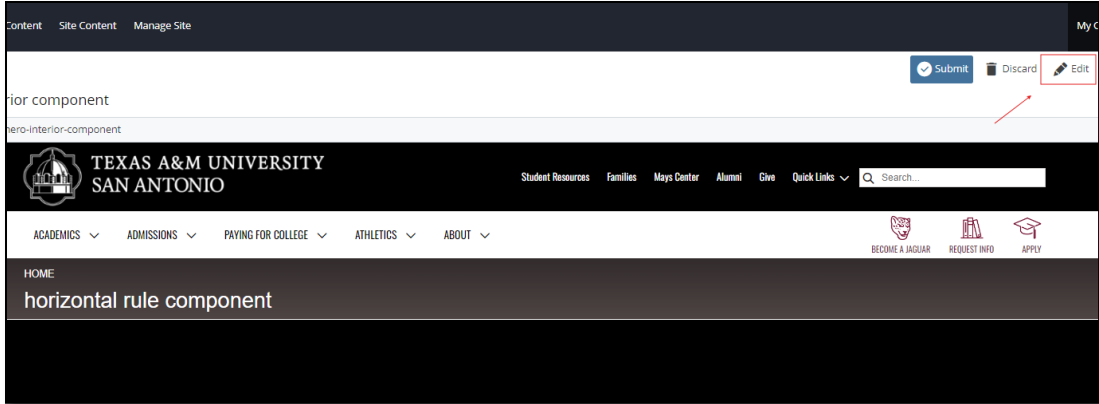


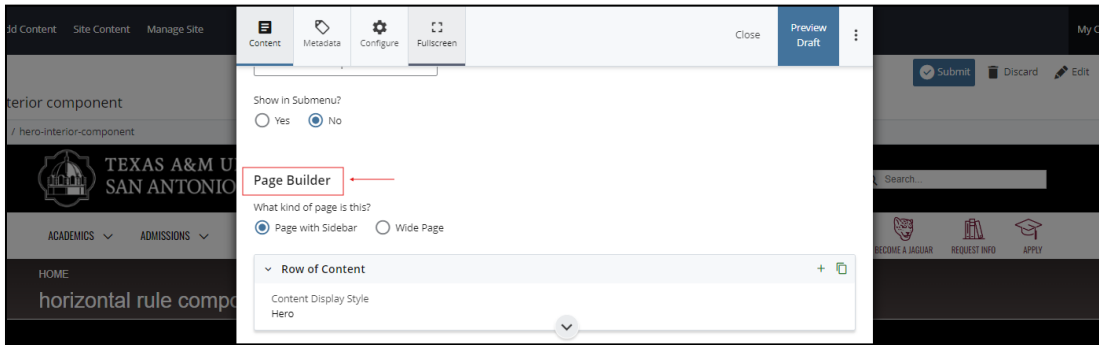
Horizontal Rule Component

This document will explain how to use the “Horizontal Rule Component”.

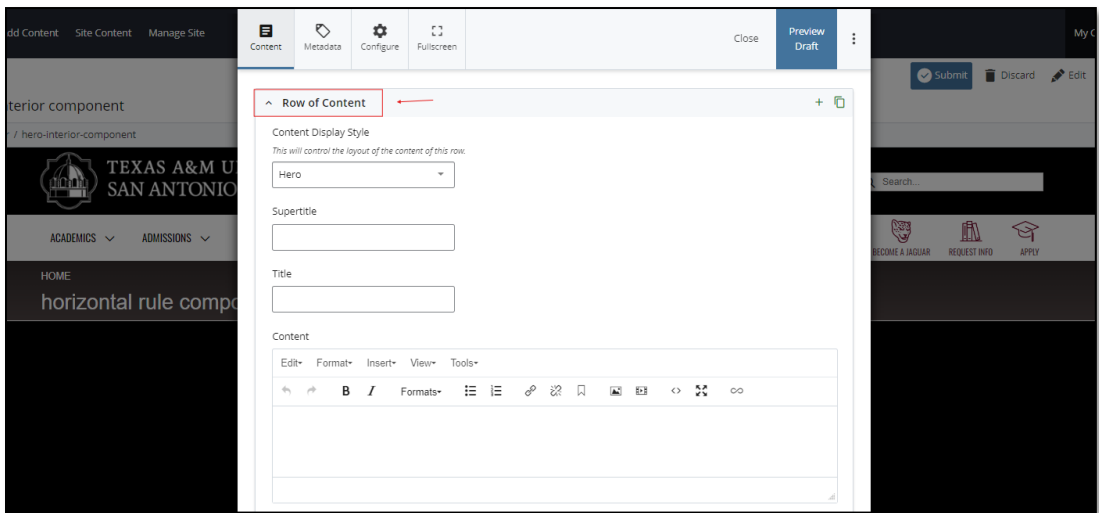
1. Click the “Edit” button at the top right of the screen. (screenshot below)



2. Navigate to “Page Builder” section, under “Show in submenu?”.

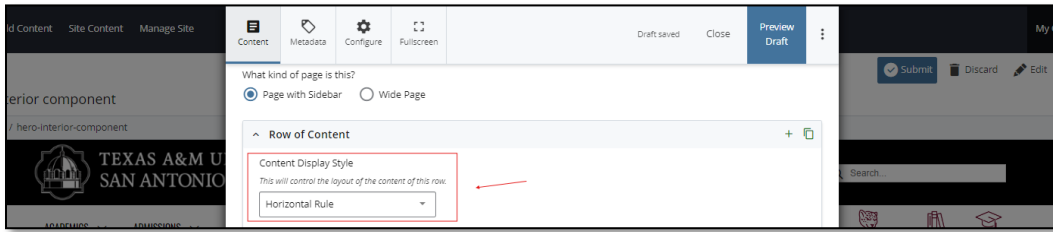


3. Open the “Row of Content” block by clicking the arrow to the left of the “Row of Content” title.

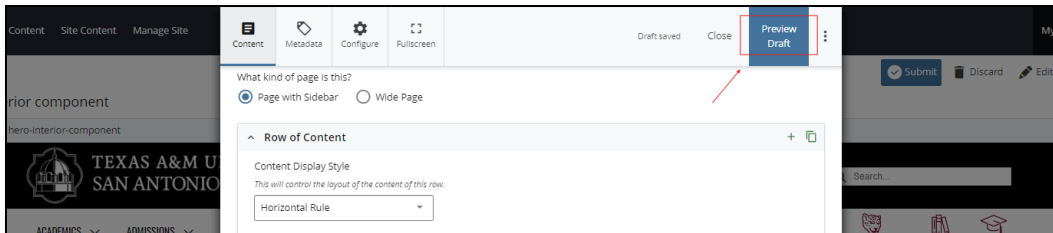

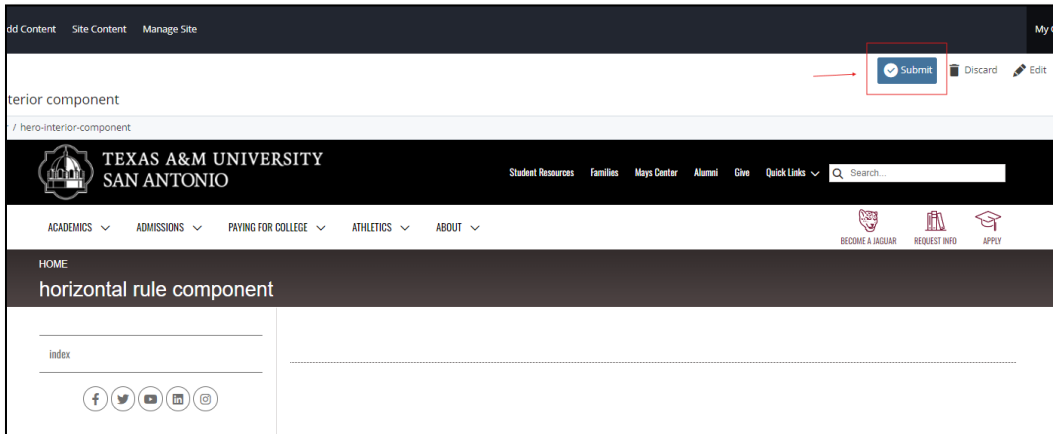
4. Open the **“Content Display Style”** dropdown menu and select the **“Horizontal Rule”** option.



5. After making edits, click on the blue **“Preview Draft”** button.



6. Once you are satisfied, click on the **“Submit”** button, otherwise click on the **“Edit”** button if you would like to continue making changes.

It serves as a simple design element that helps guide users through the content by breaking up text-heavy areas or creating a distinction between related yet separate sections, such as announcements, events, or resource links.
