

FOR BOTH ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Presentations (Power Point) are to be sent to <u>SRS@tamusa.edu</u> on April 21 for archiving on our Digital Commons. If possible, please send in both power point and pdf, as pdf works better for archiving, and power point for presenting.

Posters should be dropped off in CAB 435 by Thursday April 20 at noon. They will be hung Thursday afternoon. Posters can be picked up during the last poster session, before 6 pm on the 21st.

Electronic handouts are optional, and are due at the same time if they are to be posted, preferably in pdf for archiving.

Please arrive at least 5 minutes early to your zoom link so that you can fix any technical issues when you log in before your presentation begins.

Please have your power point open on your screen so that you are ready to share it.

There is no need to make a recording; all speaking will be done synchronously during your session.

Be prepared to take names and emails of those who ask you to send them more information.

POSTER PRESENTATIONS

You may use one of the poster templates available to you on the website, but any poster template is fine. You are welcome to be creative.

You will stay at your poster for your assigned hour to answer questions, but we will display your posters for the entire day. When you finish, please leave it up, if you are not in the last session.

Please return during the last session to retrieve your poster.

ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Plan for 12-15 minutes. You don't have to take all the time, but you can't speak longer than 15 minutes. Each session is assigned 20 minutes, so that we can smoothly switch to the next session.

The moderator will let you know when your time is almost up.

A few questions can be taken after each presentation. If you speak for the full 15 minutes there will only be a few minutes for questions while we switch to the next session.
