VISUAL

You like use of images, maps, charts and graphic organizers.

Tips: Underline, highlight, use colored pens for topics, add pictures/images to lecture notes, use drawings and diagrams when studying, replace words with symbols and turn visuals into words.

AUDITORY

You prefer listening to information and talking with others to share/gain knowledge.

Tips: Explain ideas/concepts to others, use a tape recorder, read notes out loud, say answers out loud when studying for tests.

KINESTHETIC

You prefer a hands-on approach to learning.

Tips: Find ways to add sensory experiences to your learning, i.e., scents, experiments, videos, samples, jot down several examples in notes, write out as much as you can when practicing problems, and writing down answers, use case studies when possible.
