

# 2011-2012 Graduate Catalog Amendment

## **MANDATORY FEES** *(All fees are payable at registration.)*

### ***Academic Advising Fee***

This fee is charged at \$7 per semester credit hour with a cap at 14 hours to defray cost associated with providing advising services and operating the Advising Center.

### ***Distance Learning Fee***

A fee charged at \$40 per semester used to help fund the development and delivery of online, hybrid and face-to-face courses such as: the development and production of electronic content, faculty development, Blackboard licensing and hosted and local storage space, online/telephone student help desk services, as well as acquisition, deployment and support of hardware and software applications that are directly related to learning technologies.

### ***eBook Fee<sup>1</sup>***

Any student who enrolls in a course that requires a university e-book will be automatically charged an e-book course fee in their overall tuition and fees.

### ***Energy Fee***

A fee charged at \$3 per semester credit hour with a cap at 14 hours used to offset utility expenses to include electricity, gas, water and waste water.

### ***ID Card Fee***

This is a flat fee that is charged at \$10 per semester. Funds will be used to support student IDs and the cost of operation.

### ***International Education Fee***

This fee is charged at a flat rate of \$3 per semester. Funds are used to support cultural diversity within the student body and to enhance student knowledge of other countries through international study and scholarships.

### ***Library Fee***

This fee is charged at \$11 per semester credit hour to defray expenses associated with providing University library services.

### ***Safety & Security Fee***

A fee charged at \$7 per semester credit hour with a cap at 14 hours used to offset the cost of providing police and security related services to the University community.

### ***Student Service Fee***

A service fee of \$14.30 per credit hour is charged to all students attending the University. This fee is used to support student activities and support services including Student Government Association, student organizations, student newspaper, and New Student Orientation.

### ***Technology Fee***

A fee charged at \$15 per semester credit hour charged to provide, operate and maintain equipment, and staff facilities that help promote computer awareness and access across the institution.

### ***Transcript Fee***

This fee is also charged at a flat rate of \$10 per semester. Funds are used to pay the cost of printing transcripts upon request for current and former students as well as to enhance our ability to serve our students' needs through the electronic transcript process.
